Smti Y.W. Ringu, Deputy Commissioner-Cum-Chairman, District Level Monitoring Committee presided over the meeting and urged the Head of Departments who have been funded under various heads like ACA, SPA, NEC, NLCPR, RIDF and Prime Minister package to present the status of physical and financial achievement during the current financial year. She insisted proper utilization of funds and timely completion of work to concerned Department and requested them to submit Utilization Certificate on time. She further added that prior to implementation of any schemes/proposals the District Administration should be informed about the project/programme.

Shri J.K. Sivanandan, EE, PWD has apprised the House regarding physical and financial achievement of project during the current financial year under PM's package and SPA schemes. He assured the house that all possible efforts would be taken up for proper implementation and early completion of targeted project. (Detail project report confined to PWD department is to be submitted separately to the District authority for preparation of consolidated report and submission to the Govt. thereof).

Dr. M. Basar, representative of District Medical Officer, Roing apprised the House that 1 (One) Dental Unit at District Hospital, Roing has been constructed by PWD Department which has been equipped with dental apparatus and now functional. He further apprised the house that the construction of Sister's duty room, Patient dining Hall, Doctor's emergency duty room, C.C. Water Tank and repairing and renovation, roof painting and Iron netting and other miscellaneous works under taken and completed by PWD Department. He said that the split up expenditure was not given to Medical department by the work executing Agency.

The Head of the Work executing Agencies like, DRDA, WR PWD, Elect, RWD have read out the house regarding the physical and financial achievement of various project taken up for implementation. They further assured the House that no stone would be left unturned for immediate implementation and early completion of projects. (The detail project report to be submitted by concerned Department for consolidation and submission of report to the

Shri Namo Lingi, Zilla Parishad Member spoke and said that it is the first kind of District Level Monitoring Committee meeting in the district. He thanked Deputy Commissioner, Roing for her endeavor and zeal to promote such meeting in the District. He expressed his deep resentment towards Head of Departments who did not turn up to meeting. He said mere sending of representative to attend meeting is not appreciated rather it is discouraged to repeat such practice in future. He further added that HODs should have consultative meeting with PRIs prior to issue of work order to contractor. He also warned of Law & Order situation in the district if the PRIs are ignored by HODs for consultation while implementing any project in the district. He suggested that the work/project of above Rs.50.00 Lakhs should be tendered observing all codal formalities.

Shri Namo Lingi, ZPM, Roing Anchal Samiti Block also said that the WRD Division never consulted the elected PRI Leader before preparing AOP and in work allotment, thus deviating from the actual system of work. He urged upon the E.E. WRD that henceforth this habits or system should not be repeated rather he should maintain more transparency in working system in his Department.

Shri Anjitha Menjo, ZPM, Iduli Anchal Block made a democratic appeal to all members to keep the decorum and dignity of the meeting, create conducive atmosphere and work for better achievement of works in the district. He further emphasized over transparency and insisted for physical verification of work undertaken by the Arunachal Iron and Steel Traders, Likabali for construction of Water purifying Tank near botanical Garden/Parl. He requested Executive Engineer, RWD to plant more Mimosa plant in the river bank of Deopani to stop soil erosion.

Shri. Mibom Partin, ZPM, Meka Anchal Block at the very out set thanked Deputy Commissioner, Lower Dibang Valley District Roing and In-charge District Planning Officer who called upon the District Level Monitoring Committee Meeting to review the developmental works undertaken by the various Executing Agencies. He requested Deputy Commissioner, Roing to provide guidelines to know the procedure for monitoring of schemes etc. He discouraged tender system for Lower level of Contract works as tender system would become more complicity for those local, ignorant and petty contractors of the area. He also suggested that the District Level Monitoring Committee meeting should be conducted in general instead of localizing to concerned HODs of Executing Agencies and Members of the locality.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from the Chair.
